



- The lack of medicines is an issue that has transcended over the last decades in the country.
- Frida Romay Hidalgo, head of the Health and Wellbeing area of the Zero Shortage Organization, mentions that 2021 was the year in which there was the largest shortage of medicines since 2017, as well as a doubling of the shortage in the last 2 years.

Consequences

- According to figures from Cero Desabasto (2021), out-of-pocket spending increases by 40%, inequitable access to medicines; greater practice of self-medication; illegal trade of inputs; and increase in deaths due to diseases.







- Frequency with which you attend the hospital.





- Suffering from chronic diseases.





- Hereditary diseases or conditions.







- Difficulty getting medications





- Causes that prevent access to medications




Results

- Problems caused by medication shortages.




